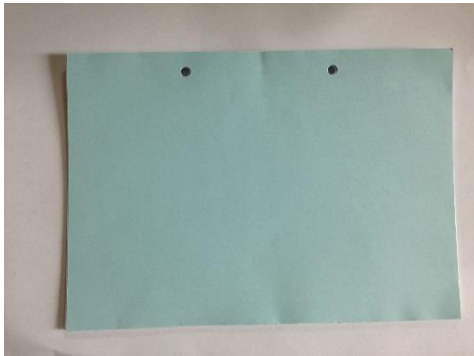
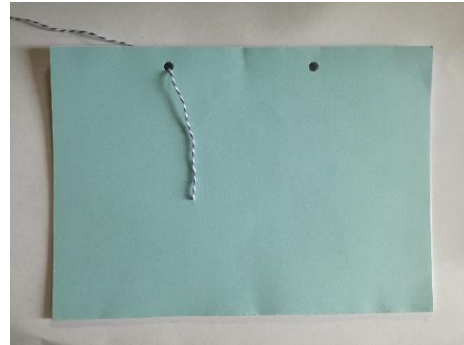


## Book Binding - instructions



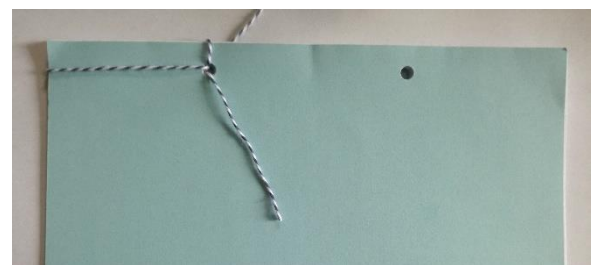
1. Place your front cover, folded pages and back cover on top of each other. Punch two holes.



2. Use a length of string (roughly 50 cm). Thread through the first hole leaving a 'tail' behind.



3. Bring the string back to the front of your work. Thread it through the same hole creating a loop at the top of your book.



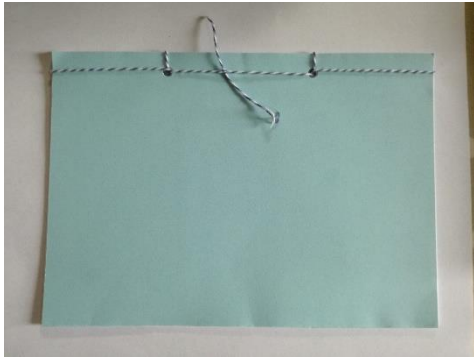
4. Again, bring the string back to the front of your work and thread it through the same hole. This will create a loop around the side of your book.



5. Bring the string along the back of your book. Thread it through the second hole from back to front. Thread it through again to create a loop at the top of your book.



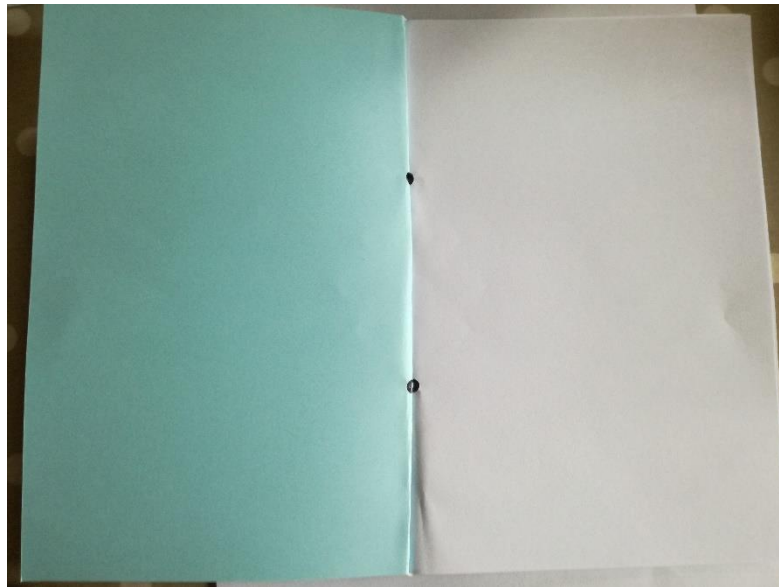
6. Once more, thread the string from the back of your book to the front, this time creating a loop around the side of your book.



7. Tie together the two loose 'tails' at the back of the book and trim away any excess.



8. You have now bound your book! To make it easier to open, it can be useful to fold along the horizontal line made by the string.



9. Start writing in your book! Experiment using different kinds of paper (lined, squared, water-colour etc) and different kinds of cover.
